Attached to this letter are your child's results from the Oklahoma School Testing Program (OSTP) assessments administered in spring 2023. Given in grades 3-8, these tests measure knowledge and skills from the Oklahoma Academic Standards.

In addition to this paper copy, you will now be able to access this information through a Parent Portal on the Measured Progress website <https://okparentportal.emetric.net>. In order to access this information, you will need your student's 10-digit student state testing number and date of birth which are listed on the student report under state ID and birth date.
