They lived with an older sister & her boyfriend, their pregnant Mother, step Father & GrandFather, (11 living in 2 rooms). The 2 older boys worked in the fields. The six children have never been to School, Neto & his siblings are in The Benner Christian School, Neto likes school.

He likes to play soccer and to ride the tricycle. The children are happy in Shalom and are adjusting well. Neto is healthy & is very active. All the children have daily chores and the six Ramirez children are good little workers. They wash their clothes, clean their rooms, plus other chores. Neto enjoys the daily devotions, Sunday School & church Services, in the Living Stones Church, located at the Home.
